LOCAL GREENHOUSE GOES GREENER WITH ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

Carbon reduction and "Waste to Flowers" initiative spotlighted in the Bay State

RAYNHAM, MA – Olson's Greenhouses, Inc. (Olson's) announced today that it has entered into an environmental management services agreement with GS EnviroServices, (OTCBB: GSEN). A pillar of strength in the community for over 90 years, Olson's operates 225,000 square feet of greenhouses, 60 (sixty) acres of outdoor production and has a Class A Recycling Permit for the recycling of one million gallons per year of on-specification of oil and water. Olson's has been recycling on specification waste oil to cost effectively power its operations for twenty five (25) years and maintains a strong commitment to the environment within which it operates. The Agreement calls for the management of marketing and environmental services for waste oil and water and is part of GS EnviroServices' overall strategy to focus on the recycling and reuse of carbonaceous materials.
